## PASTOR'S MESSAGE

### The Holiest Week Leads to the Paschal Mystery

This week we begin the most beautiful and richly symbolic liturgies of the year. We call it Holy Week.



It starts this weekend with Palm or Passion Sunday when we receive palm as a reminder of Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem, when he was hailed as King only to be rejected when he disappointed the Jews. He would be a different kind of Messiah and show the potency of powerlessness to trust in God's love and redemption.

Tomorrow night, Cardinal Tobin gathers the priests and representatives of each parish and institution to bless the Holy Oils, which we display in the ambry in each of our two churches: Oil of Catechumen for Baptism, Oil of Chrism for Confirmation and Oil of the Sick. Fr. Phil will represent our parish at this liturgy. And any parishioners are welcome. There is plenty of off-street parking around the Cathedral. The Mass begins at 8 PM but get there early since

the cathedral fills up.

These oils will be presented at our Holy Thursday Mass this Thursday and placed in the ambry. I always find this liturgy to be the most inspiring of the year. It is the reason we gather and celebrate Mass every Sunday. We recall Jesus dining with his apostles and followers at Passover. We have 12 parishioners who will have their feet washed after the homily. There is one collection for the poor. The Mass is celebrated at OLG and is bilingual. The church will remain open until 10 PM for private prayer before the Blessed Sacrament. It is also a tradition to visit other churches and Hoboken is ideal for that mini-pilgrimage since there are several churches within walking distance. After Mass, many liturgical items are removed from the sanctuary in preparation for Good Friday, when no Mass is celebrated. It is the only day of the year when we use Blessed Sacrament from Holy Thursday.

Good Friday is celebrated in four parts. The priest prostrates himself in front of the altar for a period of silence. This Good Friday, Cardinal Tobin has asked us to remember the victims of clerical abuse in a special way so we can repent for this period of the church's scandal. There are then special prayers of the faithful followed by the veneration of the Cross and then reception of the Eucharist. There is one collection for the Holy Land. We then exit silently. We pray the Stations of the Cross in OLG Church at 3 PM.

The Spanish community begins a procession from OLG to St. Joseph at 5 PM for a 6:30 PM Spanish service for Good Friday. Along the way they pray the Stations of the Cross in the streets.

The Easter Vigil, contrary to what people say is not as long and usually last for 75 minutes. We enter a darkened church illuminated from the Paschal candle blessed in the front of OLG with lit tapers, which we extinguish at the Gloria, when all the lights are turned on and the bells are rung. We have special readings, which recount our salvation history, and sing a litany in preparation for welcoming new Catholics to the church. They are baptized, confirmed and take Communion for the first time. We also bless the water that is used throughout the Easter season.

The Triduum of three days are meant to be one continuous liturgy. If you know someone who is thinking of becoming Catholic, bring them or invite them to one or all of these liturgies. I make this a special time of retreat and hope you will, too. Despite all we face personally and in the church, let us pray for hope and new life.

## KELLY HALL

In the early 20<sup>th</sup> century, OLG had an orphanage, which was located where the Willow Parking lot is now. It was razed in 1974 but the small building known as Kelly Hall remains. The basement houses our



huge boilers for the church and school along with some storage. Two years ago we spent \$130,000 to stabilize, restore the original brick, add new stairs, windows, doors. Now it's time for us to dream about how we can design the upper floor for a social justice need that we have in the 21<sup>st</sup> century. Last weekend, 50 parishioners toured the building. We will ask you to tell us: what should we put in that space. Some recommendations so far have been to house an immigrant family temporarily until they can find permanent housing. Or be a safe house for immigrants released from detention until they can connect with family or friends. Perhaps as a residence for Jesuit Volunteers or Mercy Corps volunteers who can do service in the parish and area. What do you think? Please e-mail Fr. 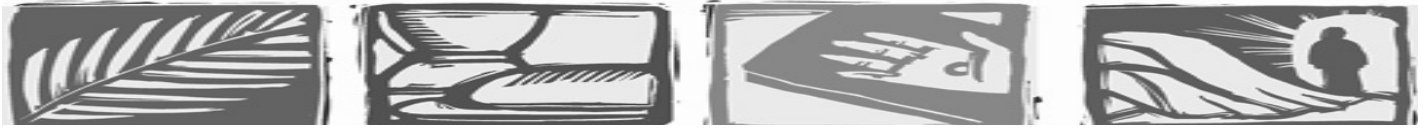

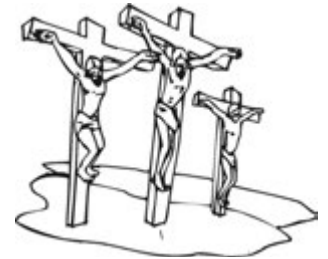

When all the lights are turned on in Our Lady of Grace, the church looks magnificent after our five year restoration. Thank you for your weekly and ongoing generosity.

Now we have to address exterior repairs, which we started last Fall. The front of OLG needs more protective work, some pointing around is necessary and the fence



needs repairs. At St. Joseph, we are installing new church doors and have moved the location of the

handicapped ramp to make it more affordable. It has been two years that we have been plastering

and painting Our Lady of Grace Church and there's still more to do. People keep asking, "When will we

be done?" When I tell Alexi Sumberac, our craftsman and artisan, he begins to itemize all the damage.

He and his associate, Elliott, work six days a week. But the evidence of restoration is abundant.

This process is a bit like our journey of faith. We know where we are going but often have to stop and

ask how we are getting there. Easter is one of the touch points in our Christian faith. It's the moment

when we know that new life is always here and it

beckons us to stay the course.

Easter tells us that new life is within our reach as we embrace the daily challenges of life. Restoring our

historic churches is a gift given to us at this moment in time of Hoboken. And St. Joseph will be done

once OLG finishes. We can do what our founders did 156 years ago and that is prepare our houses of

worship for the next 100 years. Please make a generous Easter donation and help us reach our OLG

goal of \$32,000 and St. Joseph, \$3,000. We will hold the collection open until Sunday, June 4, 2019,

the Feast of Pentecost, the end of the Easter season. We will then publish a list of all donors \$75 or
